Argauer will watch the training game, which is being held in the hall by the Brazilians. The training was attended by such players as Pele, Vava, Ziko, Didi, Garrincha. He is interested in a mini-football game and offers to organize competitions. The game in the way of the Examiner left warm impressions in everyone. Gradually, this game began to develop in other countries as well. But in a number of countries the name of this game looks different. For example, in the US and Canada, the name "Indor-sokker", that is, the name of the Hall - football. A number of countries with the name" tashen-Football " call this game. For example, in mini-football GFR is called so, and its meaning is "cho'ntak-football". The name of the game in the Dutch country is called "tsaal-football", in Brazil – "football de salon".

In 1972, the former Union team took part in international competitions organized on mini-football. Since the 70-ies in the former Union, among the skilled players during the winter season, mini-

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football competitions Spartacus have been regularly organized. Athletes from such countries as Hungary, Bulgaria and Poland took part in these competitions. Since 1977 year, these competitions have not been held.

In the following years, there has been an increasing interest in small football in Jahan. In different countries, some players prefer to only engage in mini-football. The International Football Association (FIFA) has decided to take mini-football under its care. Under the flag of FIFA, three eksperemental competitions on mini-football were organized. The competitions were held in the countries of Vengria, Brazil and Spain. The results of these competitions showed that this type of competition was one of the very popular games when worried by the national teams. FIFA's special committee was entrusted with the development of the rules of competitions on mini-football.

The first mini-football championship competitions took place in Holland in January 1989 year. In the final match, the Brazilian national team won the title of champion of the world for the first time when it landed the Dutch national team in 2:1. The match for the third place took place between the US and Belgian teams. The US national team won the match with a score of 3:2 in the last match.

The Jaxon Championship showed that mini-football has had a development challenge as a form of sports in alokhi. Mini-football is not such a rough and athletic game as big football, but it is considered to be a fun and spectator game with enough intensity at one time, requiring high technical training from the players, being able to move well on the field, being able to perform good interaction with their partner during a constant time deficit.

Along with the development of mini-football in the world, both mini-football and mini-football sports have developed in the Republic of Uzbekistan. Our national team is worthy of protection of the honor of our republic in various competitions of prestige. At the Asian, Jahan Championship Competitions, our athletes are showing worthy resistance against the leading teams of Jahan. The national men's team of Uzbekistan has successfully participated in the Asian Championship. In particular, in 2001 in Texron, 2002 in Jakarta, 2004 in Mecca, 2006 in Tashkent Asian Championship competitions held in 3rd place and 2007 in the Championship bronze medals became a winner.

2006 year Tashkent will host the Asian Championship competitions. In total, 16 Asian strong teams participate in the competitions. The champion of these competitions was the Japanese national team. The second place was occupied by Mini-players from Uzbekistan. The third place was won by the Iranian team.

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
