operating. Enhancing the culture of tolerance and humanity in society, ensuring interethnic and interfaith harmony, civil harmony, as well as strengthening friendly, equal and mutually beneficial relations with foreign countries is one of the priorities of state policy of Uzbekistan.

The attitude of the Muslim population in Uzbekistan to Christians increased by almost 2.2% and amounted to 53.7% (in 2016 - 51.5%, in 2015 - 65.2%, in 2014 - 54.1%); The number of "bad" Christians decreased by 1.7% (-2.2% in 2016, 0.6% in 2015, and almost 3.1% in 2014); Indifference to Christians accounted for 21% of respondents (-30% in 2016, 14.2% in 2015, and 27.8% in 2014).

In this regard, we can agree with V. Kuchkarov that the understanding of national identity is impossible without sociopolitical processes, but they are inextricably linked. The advantage and political correctness of such an approach is that the understanding of national identity leads to a correct understanding by any ethnic group or unit that it is not superior to others, but equal to them. and it is extremely relevant in a multinational and confessional social space. For a nation will not be big or small in a common social space, if the principles of democracy are decided in this space, there will be a right of mutual equality between nations. Here no nation or people will prevail, only the law will prevail, all nations, large and small, will have equal rights before the law.
